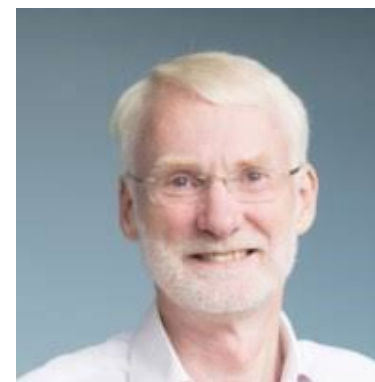

EN RLMM

How Can a Systematic Labour Market Monitoring be Established to Support Sustainable Steering of a Region or Locality?

In European regions, many different experiences existed, but there was no exchange as a result of organisational, cultural, and language barriers

- Universities and researchers develop monitoring concepts, which the practitioners are not aware of
- Labour and VET administrations carry out monitoring in the practice but do not disseminate their insights

➡ **Solution:** Establishing the **European Network on Regional Labour Market Monitoring** to bring perspectives, knowledge, and experiences from actors of different organisations in common exchange. Members are from universities/research, VET administration and practice, public employment services (PES), statistical offices, governmental bodies, non-profit organisations, and consulting.

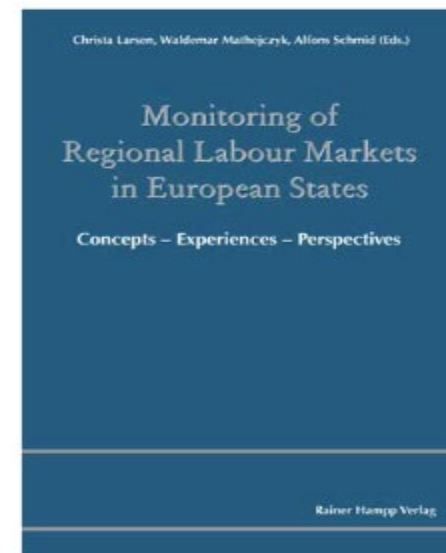

Annual Topic

Each year a topic is chosen which has to be in the interest of the majority of the network members and has to be relevant for the organisation of the annual host.

Annual Anthology

It is important to have new information, new perspectives, and new insights on the selected topics. This is secured by a state of the art assessment of each new topic. The assessment is based on inputs of around 20 network members plus a meta analysis performed by the coordinators. Both is brought into an annual anthology. Findings of the anthology build the groundwork for the programme of the annual meeting.

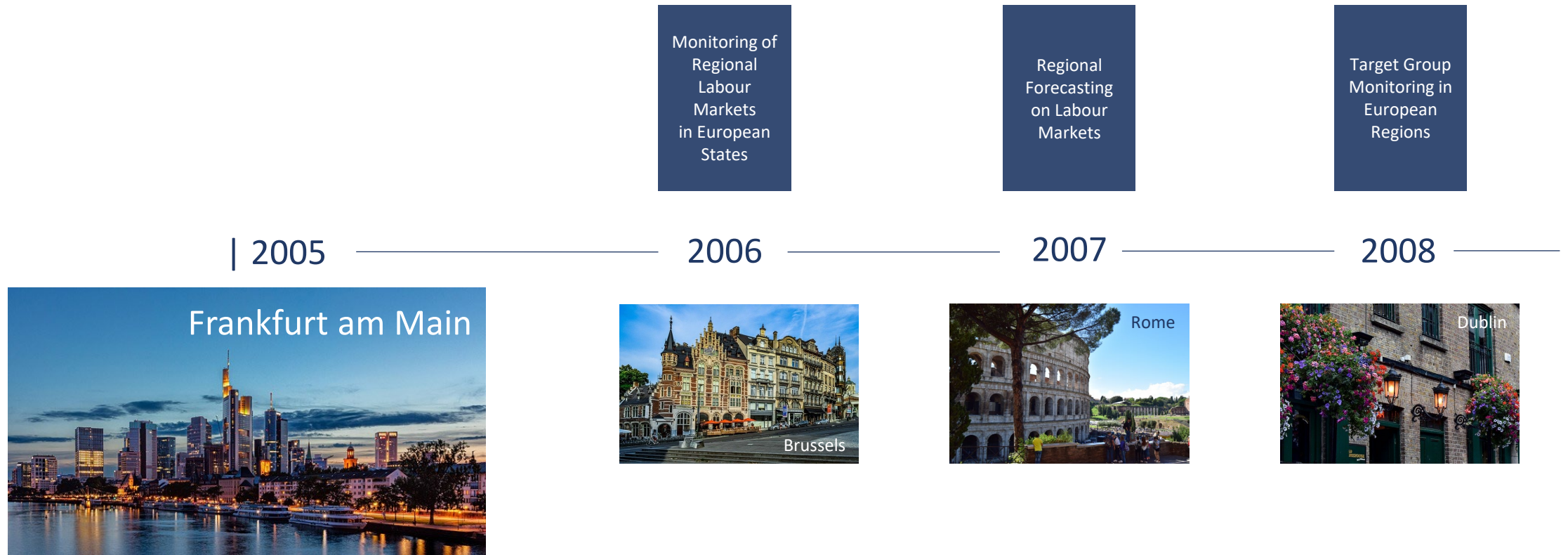
A network member takes over the role of a host and invites the other members to his organisation. Since 2006 there have been already 19 annual meetings in different regions across Europe and beyond.
